RTD May 2023 Proposed Service Changes

- Late night service on light rail lines until 12am Mon-Thurs & Sun, 2am on Fri & Sat.
- But... 30min frequencies start earlier at 6:30pm, rather than 8pm.
- FF2 reintroduced with limited peak hour trips.
- An extra trip on the FF5.
- Bus route 10 extended to Colfax / Billings in Aurora.
- Bus routes 34 & 38 merged to create a 38th Ave Crosstown. GDT campaigning to have route serve Union Station.
- New Broomfield FlexRide.
- R Line to get a 'running time analysis'.

RTD Proposed Fare Structure

- Proposed structure like Option B, one single zone & monthly fare cap / pass.
- But with Option A's reduced fares!
- \$88 monthly fare cap / pass - inc. Airport!
- Monthly fare cap / pass works out cheaper after only 32 trips - down from 38.
- LiVE (low income) discount aligned with other ADA / senior discounts at 50%.
- ADA / senior / LiVE monthly fare cap / pass is \$27, works out cheaper after 20 trips.
- Airport fare reduces slightly to \$10. Discount eligible riders pay only \$1.35.
- One year trial of free youth (19 & younger) fares.

RTD Proposed Code of Conduct

- Current code of conduct introduced in 2020.
- Proposed code of conduct adds the following rules:
 17. Engaging in harassment, sexual harassment, or bullying. This includes offensive behavior, unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature, or abusive, repeated conduct directed toward an individual because of their sex, race, color, national origin, religion, marital status, sexual orientation, transgender status, pregnancy, ancestry, age, military status, disability, genetic information or any other status protected by law.
 18. Engaging in language that is violent, profane, or calculated to provoke a breach of the peace. This includes but is not limited to fighting words or threatening language that causes customers, RTD employees, or RTD contractors to fear for their safety.
 31. Lying on the floor, bench, platform, stairway, landing, ground or conveyance.
 32. Sleeping or dozing where such activity may be hazardous to the person or others or may interfere with the operation of RTD's system or the comfort of RTD customers.

RTD Proposed Code of Conduct (Continued)

34. Remaining on the RTD system for more than one continuous trip without exiting the paid area and re-entering by paying or validating a second fare or riding on the system indefinitely without exiting the system as indicated by the totality of the circumstances.
39. Occupying or remaining on RTD property where the totality of the circumstances indicates that an individual is not using RTD services, contracting lawful business, engaging in protected speech, or otherwise exercising a fundamental right.
42. Unauthorized use of an electrical or data outlet..
- Also includes amendments to suspension from RTD system policies.
 - Proposed code of conduct approved by RTD Operations & Safety Committee on, will now go to full board for approval on Feb 28th.
